# From the Pastor's Desk



It is time to plant. Time to get the roto-tiller out, buy several bags of manure and compost and churn up the earth and make the ground ready for planting. After the ground is sufficiently turned over, Sue and I will carefully plant our tomatoes, beans, peppers, basil and other herbs, and flowers. It is a time for planting in preparation of new life in the garden. New life that reminds us of God's restorative nature in Creation.

In the church, we also set our sights on New Life. The festive season after Easter and leading up to Pentecost and Holy Trinity have revealed the goodness of God that exists in the breath of life that fuels our faith. The gift of the Holy Spirit, the presence of all Three Persons of the Trinity, remind us of the fullness of God.

As we enter into the long season, the Time After Pentecost, in the book of Joshua, we read:

#### choose this day whom you will serve Joshua 24:15

Joshua reminds the ancient people as they are about to enter the promised land, that God has been steadfast in providing safety and honoring the covenant. Joshua reminds the people of a choice they have. Serve God or serve false gods. Paul in his letter to the Romans explains we can serve the flesh or the Spirit. (Romans 8). Life in the Spirit is defined by grace, peace, and harmony

The Season After Pentecost is a time for growing New Life in the Word. The Altar Guild gets a much-deserved breather as we settle into the "green season" without change until October. We focus on the life of the Church as it grows in the midst of the world. The lectionary will guide us through Gospel readings that cover the teaching of Jesus' ministry.

As we emerge from our COVID restrictions, we can re-connect with our church as we re-gather in the sanctuary, as we celebrate outdoor worship in the parking lot, as we welcome children into Vacation Bible School, as we work the Food Trucks, and as we present ourselves with renewed commitment to Sharing Christ's Love in joyful response to the grace we have received.

## UPDATE on Sound System Upgrade Project

Over the past month, we have been finalizing equipment for the sound system upgrade. This new equipment will include microphones, speakers in the church, choir loft and Fellowship Hall with a new amplifier and mixing unit. Additionally, we have designed portions of the system to be mobile in order to save cost. As indicated last month and earlier, the cost of the project is estimated to be around \$15,000 to complete. This upgrade will greatly improve our in-person worship experience along with our Facebook Live or other video ministry via email or website.

The council decided that we would do a fundraiser for this sound system project. Additionally, one of our church families has agreed to make a matching donation for a portion of the total cost, based on how much we are able to raise from the congregation during this fundraising activity. I am



happy to report that as of this writing, members have donated over \$2,000 (Thank You Very Much!) and an additional \$2,000 in a matching donation has been committed to the project. (Thank You!)

We still have a long way to go on our fundraising, so, if interested in supporting this needed sound system upgrade, please indicate on your weekly giving or other envelope "Sound System". Thank You in advance for supporting this project!

### Face Masks and Other Church Restrictions UPDATE

The council has made the decision to stop the requirement for wearing masks for those in groups of 20 or less while in the church. However, we will continue with masks during our church services or larger gatherings until further notice. Those that are not yet vaccinated are encouraged to continue wearing masks along with those that feel more comfortable with a mask. We ask those not yet vaccinated to use the honor system and to wear a mask to protect yourself and others. We also encourage you to get vaccinated as soon as you can.

No more temperature checks will be done. Communion will continue to be prepackaged at this time. The collection plate will remain at the back of the church for the time being as well.

Fellowship time after service will resume June 6<sup>th</sup> with tables spread out in the fellowship hall.

These same guidelines will be used during Thursday evening worship at 7:00pm.

Your church council will review monthly what is happening with the pandemic and will adjust worship guidelines accordingly.
