# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

## And he will destroy on this mountain the shroud that is cast over all peoples (Isaiah 25:7)

The shroud of the pandemic that has covered us is slowly being lifted. Maintaining masks, distances, hygiene, getting vaccinated, appears to be destroying the virus on this mountain known as Zion Lutheran Church.

The shroud that is lifted reveals new hope and new truth, as we proclaim:

#### Alleluia! He is Risen!! He is risen, indeed, Alleluia!!

We proclaim the Good News, entering the month of May witnessing the new life of the season. As we put away the snow shovels and snow blowers, and replace them with shovels, and seed, and rototillers and lawn mowers, we see signs of freshness in the springtime around us. We are comforted by the Advocate who comes at **Pentecost** to counsel and comfort us. The Holy Spirit comes to guide our faith and encourage us on the mission.

## Sound System Upgrade Project

Many of you have indicated during this past year of online worship that Zion needed to do something to improve the sound system in the church. Over the past couple of months, we have been investigating and trialing some new sound equipment. Based on the equipment trial and your feedback, the council has voted to move ahead with upgrading all of the sound equipment in the church Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall. This upgrade will enhance the



sound of our in-person worship, as well as our on-line and video ministry outreach on Facebook or via email link for those unable to attend church. Since the cost of this project is around \$15,000 to complete, the council decided that we would do a fundraiser for this sound system project. Additionally, one of our church families has agreed to make a matching donation for a portion of the total cost based on how much we are able to raise from the congregation during this fundraising activity. Since timing of this project is important and there is a several-week lead time for equipment, we would like to see how much we are able to raise during the month of May. Pioneer Club will be meeting for lunch and **BINGO** on **May 17th at 11:30am**. We


